DML Ministry Among the Masai

Pastor James Kamau (left) is a Kenyan who has been a missionary to Tanzania for more than twenty years. He is passionate about people coming to a full understanding of who God is and what our call is to be His children. He has worked with International Christian Ministries for many years, is the principal of the Africa Theological Seminary in Tanzania, and several years ago began representing DML in Tanzania. Approximately two years ago, Pastor James was joined by Pastor Anthony, a young pastor who has joined the DML movement and has inspired many youth to start businesses.

In 2020, Pastor James and Pastor Anthony began to take their message to places where there were no churches: to the Masai Mara. The Masai people are pastoralists and their lives center around cattle. A man's wealth is measured by the number of cows and children that he may have.

The picture above is Pastor James with Moses, Alphonsoniana, and their two youngest sons. They have four children in total, but none of the four go to school. Last year, thanks to your support of our COVID sustainability projects, we helped Moses buy two cows at \$250/each.

Moses is Baptized

The Masai are monotheistic but the god they worship is very unlike the God of Christianity. Because of this, Pastor James and Pastor Anthony have been conducting Bible studies with the Masai, while at the same time helping them in business development. Last year, Moses came to Christ and was baptized by Pastor Anthony. We praise God for this!



Cows are like a savings account.

For the Masai people, an adult cow is like a fixed deposit account. The cows are rarely sold. Calves are like a savings account. You sell them to meet pressing needs. Milk is like a checking account. It is sold to meet daily needs. These cows give on average 1.3 litres of milk per day for a period of six months. Comfortable lives requires one to have fifteen or more milk cows. At this time, Moses and Alphonsiana

need four more cows to allow them to survive on their own, without being dependent on others.

Gifts to Moses and his family will change their lives and be a powerful witness of Christian love to the Masai people. Thank you for your partnership in serving these brothers and sisters.

AND maybe more will turn to the God of Christians, who has made them in His image, for the flourishing of all and the glory of God.
